## **Beginning March 11th Rhodes State Classes Will not be Held in Person**

LIMA, Ohio – Effective Wednesday, March 11, 2020, Rhodes State College will no longer have face-to-face classes or labs in response to the Governor’s recommendation about mitigating the spread of the coronavirus – COVID 19. Classes will resume in a remote learning format on Monday, March 16, 2020. There will be no face-to-face classes or labs. All clinical and off-campus activities (including clinicals, internships, field experience, and Bradfield Center) and all online classes will continue as scheduled.
